

- Tuition for the Company Troupe is \$125/month for April, May, August, September, October, November, December, January and February and March. This tuition is automatically billed to the card we have on file for your family..
- This tuition includes all production expenses for the performances, scripts, a Junior Company embroidered sweatshirt or jacket and tote bag.
- There are no refunds of monthly tuition payments.

Audition Information and Tips

- Auditions will be held on March 23rd, 2025.
- The link to sign up for an audition time slot is on our website. Please plan to stay the full hour of your audition slot.
- Students cast in FAPA's Junior Company will be notified no later than March 30th via email. Please make sure your email address is correct on your audition form.
- Audition forms will be available on our website no later than March 15th.

We strive to make auditions at FAPA a positive, encouraging experience, but we know they can be nerve-wracking! The absolute best way to ensure the least amount of disruptive nerves at an audition is to be fully prepared. Please read the following for how you can be most well-prepared for your audition! There are three portions to the audition: Acting, Singing and Dancing

ACTING:

- Relax! There's nothing specific to prepare!
- You can always check out Music Theatre International's website to see a character breakdown of the show as well as some snippets from the script you can read so that you're aware of the story and characters in advance.

 Google is a great place to get info to prepare!
- In the audition room, we'll give you a short cut from the script, give you some time to read over it and then ask that you read with a scene partner. (If you have reading difficulties, no problem! Just let us know ahead of time so that we can ensure you have extra time to go over the script.)

SINGING:

- Students should prepare one minute of a musical theater song with an accompaniment track.
- Please do not expect to sing longer then one minute.
- Please bring a blue-tooth speaker for your audition to eliminate technical issues from trying to connect to one of our devices on site.
- Tips for choosing an audition song:
 - Pick something that's vocally comfortable, enjoyable to sing and shows off the best parts of your voice. An audition is all about making a great impression and showing your strengths in a short amount of time. The best way to do that is by choosing something that's fun and shows off some character choices.
- Tips for your accompaniment track:
 - Please come with your track pre-saved.
 - Find the track on Youtube (search the title with "karaoke" or "instrumental" to find a track that doesn't have any voices; only accompaniment.
 - Screen record the cut of the song you'll be singing with a device like a smartphone or table. This way you don't have access Youtube in the audition room, which will eliminate issues with wifi.
 - On the audition day, come with your device and speaker already connected so that you can come in, tell us who you are and be ready to sing with minimal hassle and worry!

DANCING:

• Again, nothing to prepare in advance! Come dressed in clothes and shoes that are comfortable and easy to move in, bring a water bottle and we'll teach you a short, fun combination!
